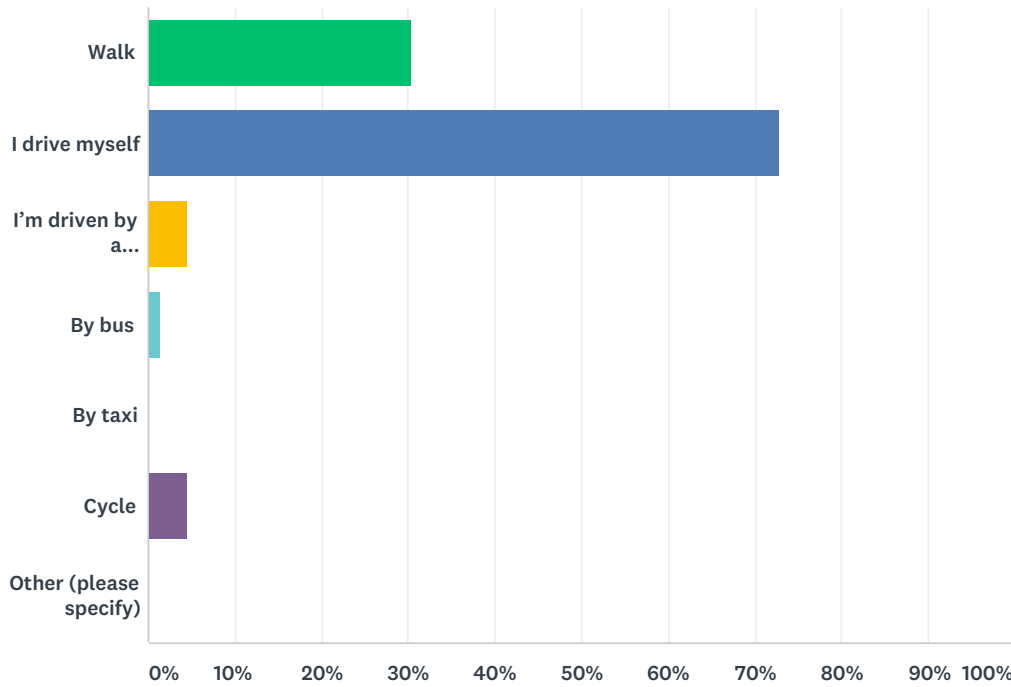


Q1 When you visit, how do you normally get there?

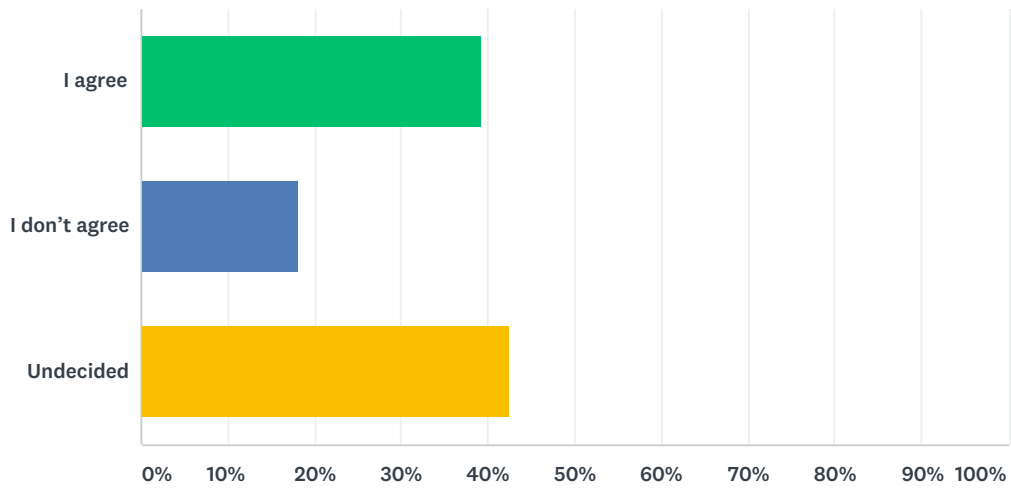

Q2 Do you agree that a new purpose built surgery will benefit patients and staff?

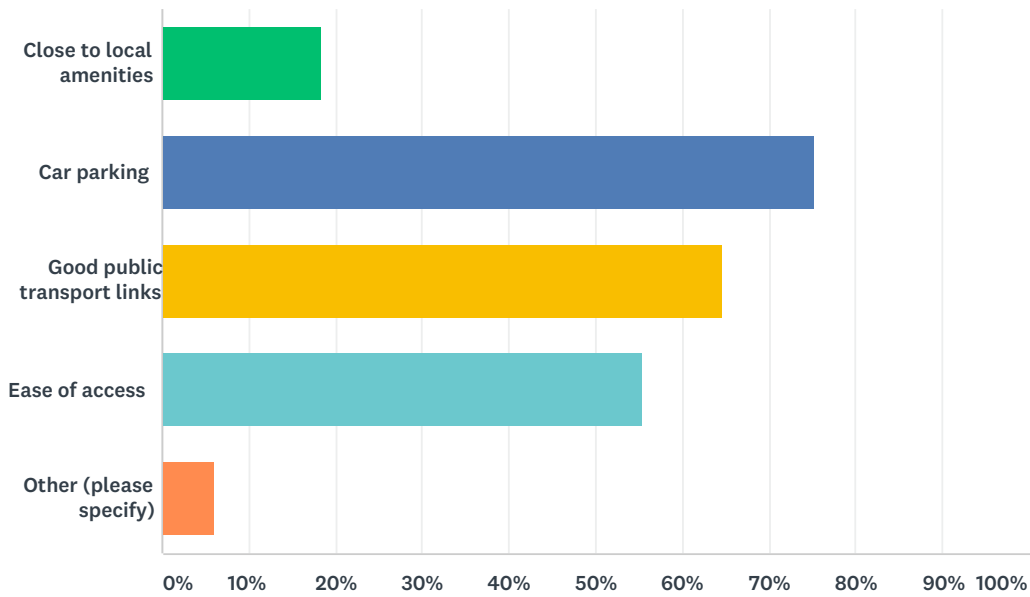

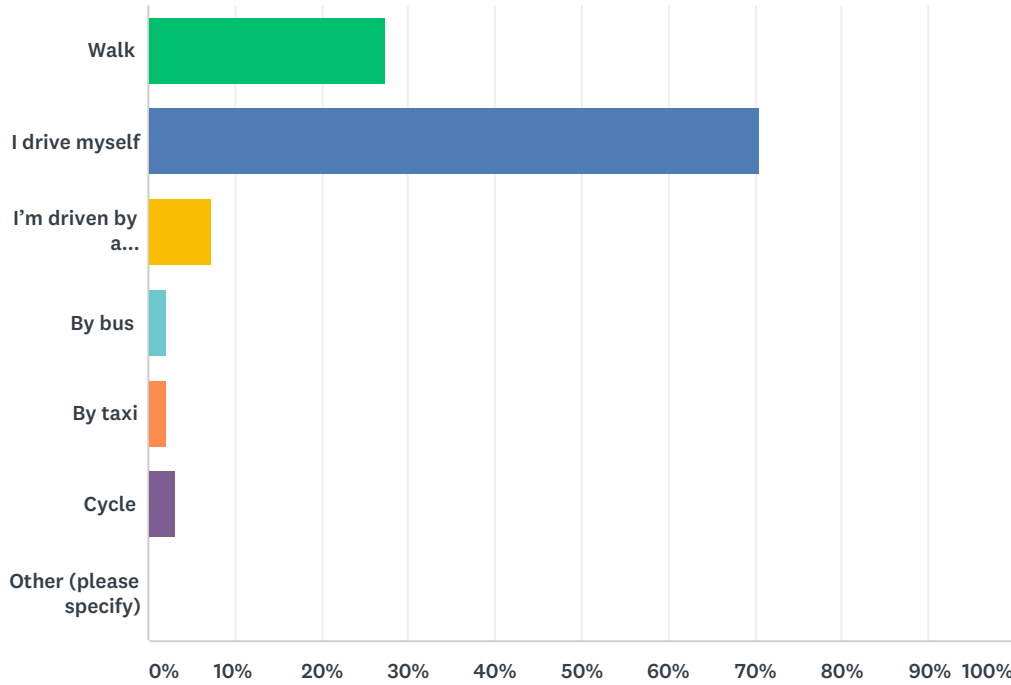

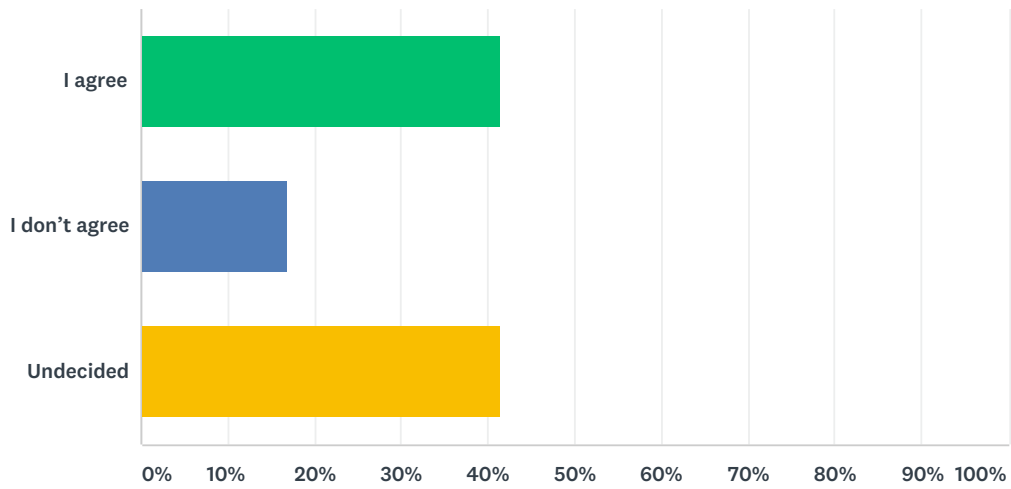

Q2 Do you agree that a new purpose built surgery will benefit patients and staff?

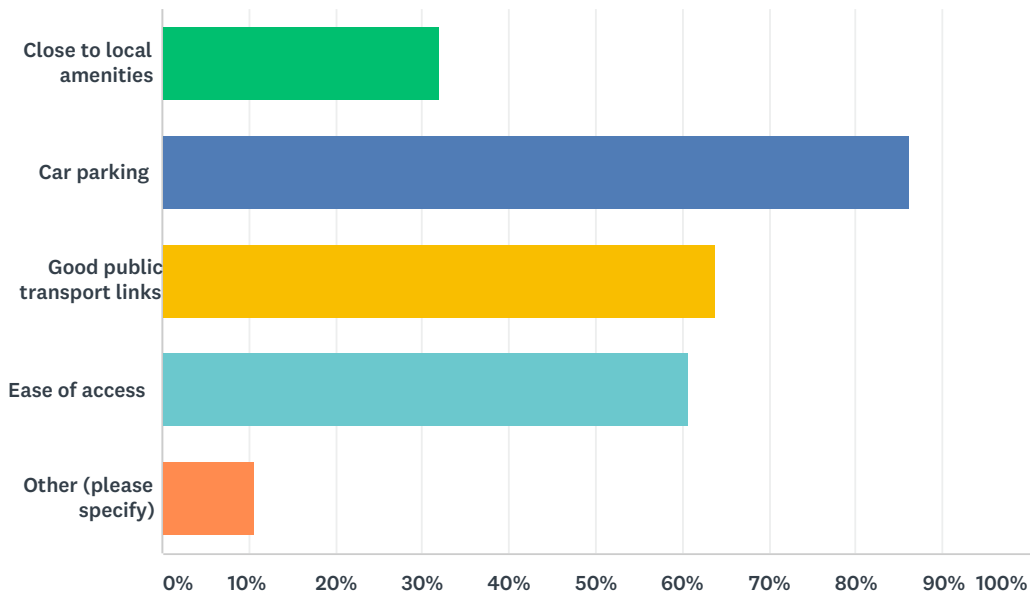

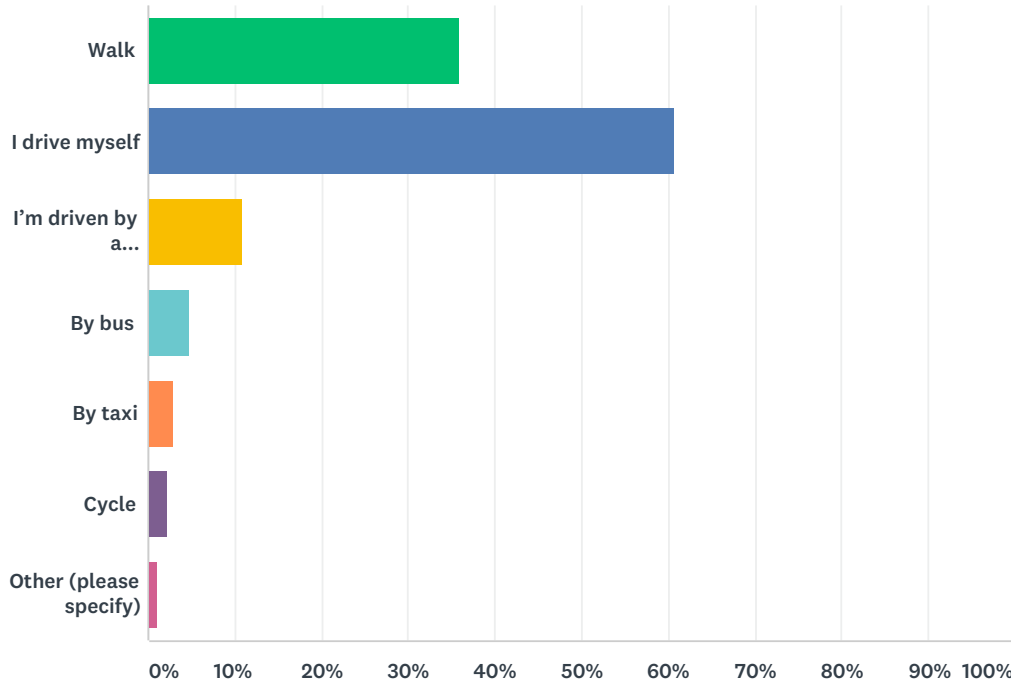

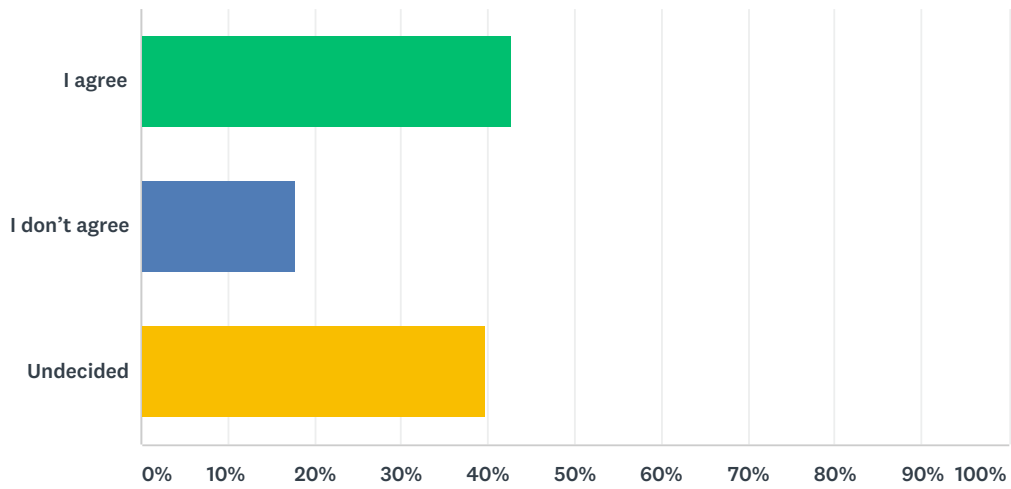

Q2 Do you agree that a new purpose built surgery will benefit patients and staff?

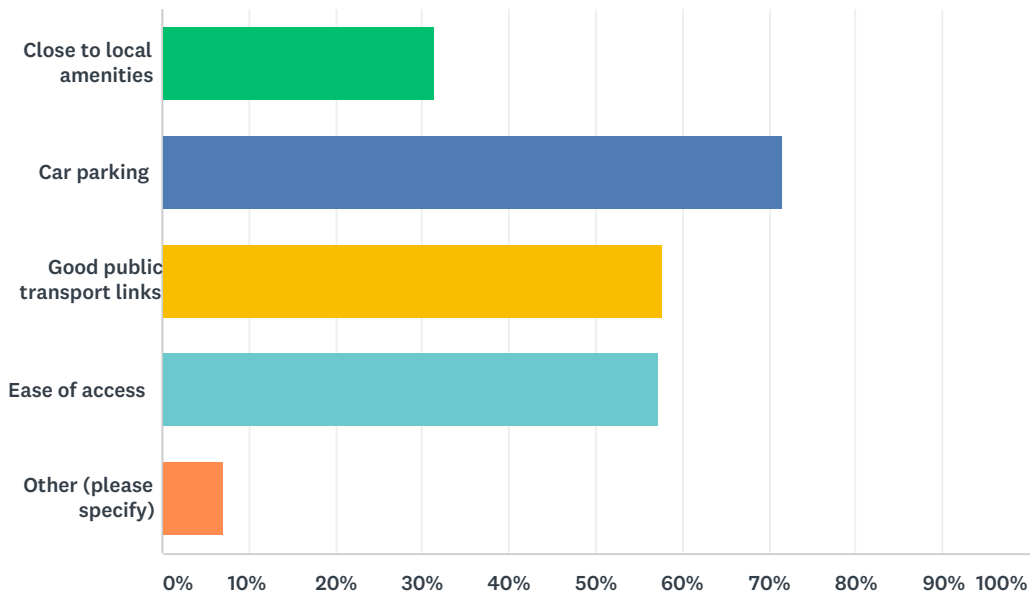

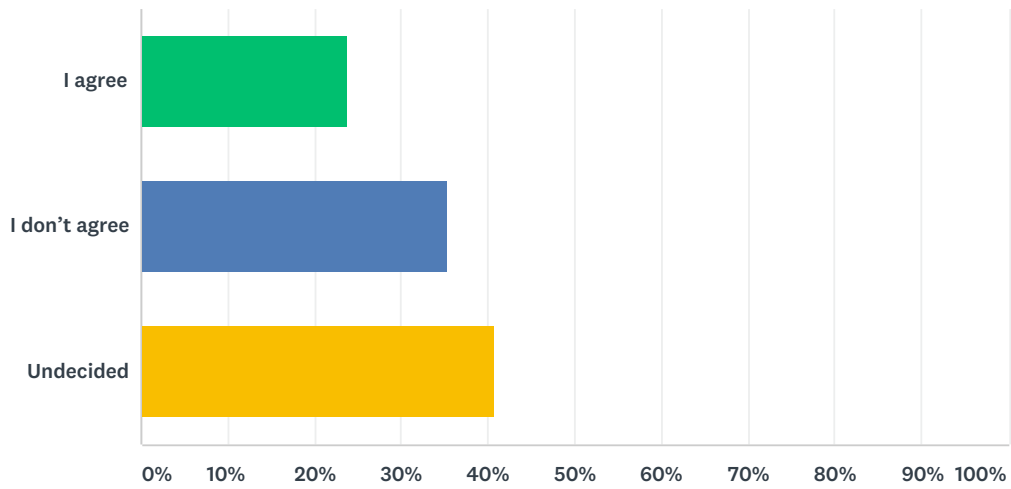

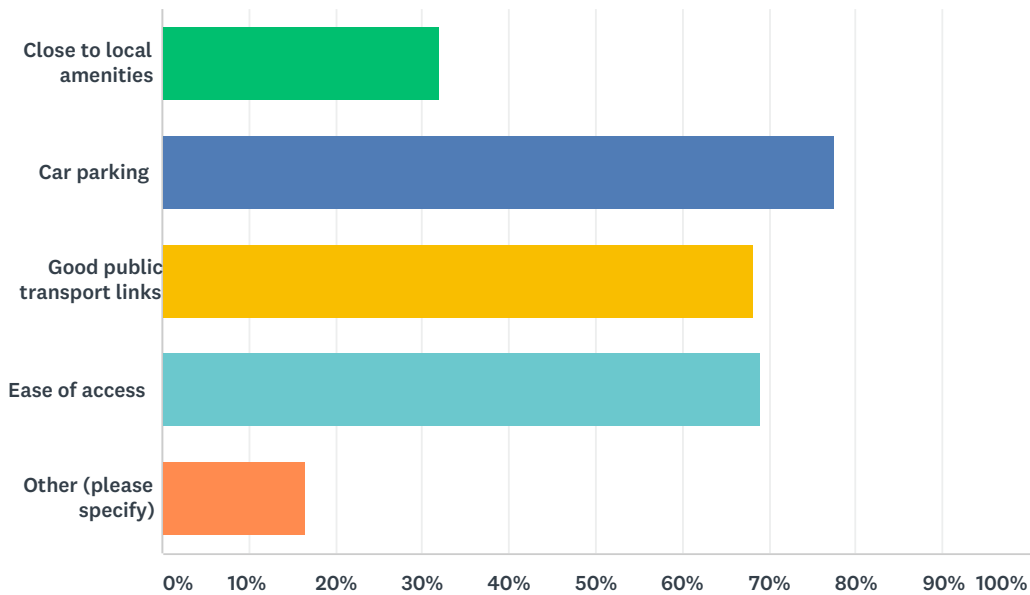
