 - Work closely with Montgomery-House PPG to align our message to patients
 - Participate in Bicester Primary Care Network
 - Attend regular PCN PPG meetings
 - Maintain informal relationships with Bicester Health Centre and Montgomery-House PPGs
- Initiate targeted patient surveys to identify issues and communicate results
