Coronavirus (Covid 19)

n December 2019 the World Health Organisation (WHO) was informed of an outbreak of a pneumonia of unknown cause in Wuhan City, China. A coronavirus was subsequently identified as the cause and was officially named the "Covid-19 virus".

The virus spread rapidly around the world, with the first case reaching the UK on 23rd January 2020. By February 2020 the first cases of person-to-person spread within the UK were confirmed. On 11th March 2020 the WHO declared Covid-19 a global pandemic and on 23rd March the UK entered its first National Lockdown.

Whilst the UK's first wave of Covid infections began to peak in May 2020, researchers in Oxford and elsewhere in the world were developing vaccines against Covid-19. The first vaccines were approved for use in the UK in December 2020 as the country was well into its second Covid wave. The national vaccination effort had begun!

During November 2020, in response to the emergency, the three Bicester practices started on a project to set up a Local Vaccination Site at Bicester Heritage. The first Covid 19 vaccinations were given from the Bicester Heritage site on 6th January 2021.

One year later - by February 2022 - a total of just over 70,000 vaccinations had been given from the site. The work and effort that so many have put into setting up and running the Bicester





and goodwill of the many volunteers and staff this would not have been possible. The speed and efficiency with which vaccinations could be rolled out locally has helped keep us all safe and will no doubt have saved many lives.

This photobook is intended to remember and celebrate all of those who took part in this historic effort. Whilst we learn to live in a world where Covid-19 has become endemic, and routine vaccination is likely to become a cornerstone of managing this problem, we would like to recognise and thank everyone who stepped up to help in this first, rapid response vaccination effort in the fight against the Covid-19 pandemic. Without you, this would not have been possible.

The Bicester GP practices held discussions to enable a vaccination centre to be set up for the population of Bicester.


Bicester Heritage was approached along with Park Display for their help.

The Hanger was a shell with just a standpipe for water and outlet for electricity.


Original Plan for Hangar 139



Sunday 12th December 2021 at 8pm, the Government announced that everybody aged over 18 should be offered the booster vaccination by the end of the year.


The Bicester practices acted very quickly and with the help of the volunteers managed to complete this by offering all eligible patients an appointment by 23rd December 2021.
